


- 1) Browser Requirements: Internet Explorer 9 and above, Google Chrome or Mozilla Firefox.
- 2) All fields with an asterisk (*) are required fields and must be filled.
- 3) If amending a form which was previously filed on the Commission's website, choose that option (see Step 5 below).
- 4) After submitting the form, the filer can obtain an official copy from the State Ethics Commission's eLibrary at: http://www.ethicsrulings.state.pa.us. The filer may also supply their e-mail address when submitting the form for an official copy to be sent via e-mail.
- 5) The filer can print this form from their web browser; however, it does not constitute an official copy of their filing.

Note: Any filings made by other Public Officials/Public Employees will be considered voluntary. All filers will still need to submit a paper version and/or a copy of their electronically filed form to all required filing locations other than the State Ethics Commission.

For forms due in 2019 for calendar year 2018, all public officials required to file with the State Ethics Commission have the option to file this form utilizing either the paper format or electronically via the Commission's Web SFI. In order to function properly, this form requires Internet Explorer 9 and above, Google Chrome, or Mozilla Firefox. Note:

At the present time, filing electronically is available only to state level public officials and public employees who are required by provisions of the State Ethics Act to file with the State Ethics Commission. Any filings made by other public officials/public employees will be considered voluntary, All filers will still need to submit a paper version and/or a copy of their electronically filed form to all required filing locations other than the State Ethics Commission.

Step 4: The page below will be displayed; read the text and then check the box below:

A: <u>Candidates</u> - Persons seeking elected state, county and local public offices, including first-time candidates, incumbents seeking re-election, and write-in candidates who do not decline nomination/election within 30 days of official certification of same.

 $\hbox{B:}\ \underline{\text{Nominees}}\ \hbox{-}\ \text{Persons nominated for public office subject to confirmation}.$

C: <u>Public Officials</u> - Persons serving as current state/county/local public officials (elected or appointed). The term includes persons serving as alternates/designees. The term excludes members of purely advisory boards.

D: <u>Public Employees</u> - Individuals employed by the Commonwealth or a polictical subdivision who are responsible for taking or recommending official action of a non-ministerial nature with regard to: contracting or procurement; administering or monitoring grants or subsidies; planning or zoning; inspecting, licensing, regulating or auditing any person; or any other activity where the official action has an economic impact of greater than a de minimis nature on the interests of any person. The term does not include individuals whose activities are limited to teaching.

A former public official or former public employee must file the year after termination of service with the governmental body.

E: Solicitors - Persons elected or appointed to the office of solicitor for policital subdivision(s).






<u>Step 5:</u> Answer the box entitled "Are you amending a prior filing?"; if answer is "No", the blank form will appear. Any field that has a (?) by the field name, the filer can point their cursor at the question mark, and additional instructions will appear as shown below:




<u>Step 6:</u> Some fields, such as field 3 "Status" shown below, will have a drop-down box for selection. For field 6, if there is a need to enter another occupation, click on the "link" circled below and an additional field will appear for input:




<u>Step 7:</u> Continue to fill out all fields as required. All fields that contain an asterisk must be filled. For field 7, the year is already defaulted (see screen shot below); however, if filing for previous years and not the current year, the filer should update this field accordingly. Note: Forms due May 1, 2020 are for calendar year 2019.




<u>Step 8:</u> If at any time there is a need to exit the form and access it later, the filer should click on the box circled below entitled "Save unfinished form to complete later", enter their e-mail address, create a password and click on the "Save" button.




Step 9: The screen below will appear and an e-mail will be sent to the e-mail address provided:





<u>Step 10:</u> To re-access the form, the filer should click on either the link in the webpage or the link in the e-mail (step 9 above). If an e-mail does not appear within a few minutes, the filer should check their "spam" folder. Once the form is complete, click on the box circled below:




<u>Step 11:</u> The following screen will now appear; the filer should type their name and the last 4 digits of their social security number in the boxes circled below. The filer should enter their e-mail address and confirm it in the 2 boxes indicated with an arrow below. Once finished, the filer should click on the "Submit" button at the bottom of the screen:




<u>Step 12:</u> If a field was missed when filling out the form, the system will prompt the filer to fill it in as shown below; once completed, click on the "Submit" button again:
